Cooking Bus comes to Horsehay Youth Group ...



On Friday 29th June we were lucky enough to have the Telford and Wrekin Cooking Bus visit our Youth Group. The bus was amazing - a bit like Dr Who's Tardis, it was much bigger inside than it looked on the outside. During the evening 16 young people took part in making their own pizzas. Archie, one of our members, recalls what the bus looked like inside and what they did:

"It had a kitchen area with all the equipment including an oven and sink. On the other side of the bus it had benches with a table in the middle. It also had a TV screen to show cooking demonstrations on. We made our dough

on the table. We had a selection of toppings to put on our pizza. We could choose which ones we wanted. The pizzas were then put into the oven. We then had a break while they cooked."

Even though it's 3 months since the cooking bus visited, young people were still able to recall the evening when asked about it for this article.

"The pizzas were really nice and it was fun to do. I had not made one from scratch before. It was the first time I had made my own dough."

"It was nice. It tasted like a good pizza. I had never made dough before."

"I liked the taste of my pizza. It had pepperoni, ham, cheese, mozzarella, then more pepperoni on top"

"It was great to test our cooking skills and it was great fun"

"I put lots of tomatoes on my pizza. It was delicious! It was the first time I had made my own pizza. "

"My pizza was really stringy. It had lots of mozzarella cheese on. I love cheese!"

"The pizzas were better than the ones I usually have. I chose my own toppings"

"I made a bread plait. It was lovely because it was warm".

This fantastic evening would not have been possible without the generosity of the Parish Council in funding the buses visit. The youth group has now been meeting for 9 months and this has proved to be one of the most popular activities we have done to date.

The 11th day of the 11th month is a day which is remembered with joy as it saw the end of the First World War of the last century.

One of the most horrific wars ever recorded. Some of us mark it for those of our families who died in the trenches of Europe. Experiences, which they felt unable to share with their spouses or their families. We all owe an enormous debt to the families of serving service personnel as without these families walking in step with the service staff our troops could not be effective in their endeavours.
